

throughput across coasts, oceans, and airways. Meanwhile, the Eutelsat OneWeb LEO satellite fleet offers ultra-low latency of under 100 ms, making it ideal for sensitive real-time applications. Both systems deliver impressive bandwidths of up to 200/32 Mbps during standard operations.
